

## The ACT Junior Chess League & ACT Chess Association announce the 2011 Women's and Girls' CHESS FESTIVAL!



The tenth annual **Women's and Girls' Chess Festival** is a two-day rated chess tournament, played with long time controls and players are expected to record their moves. Girls involved in our Girls' Allegro, or who played in the Girls' Primary or Girls' High School Championships are encouraged to attend – we think it will be a lot of fun and a great way to meet other girls who enjoy playing chess! **You can take a bye or two if you have to play netball, or soccer, or something else on the weekend!** 

Players who have not recorded moves before will be given instruction. The event is most suited to patient players who are keen to improve and develop their game. Senior players will be happy to assist with post-game analysis to ensure all participants will learn some new tricks over the weekend!

When: 21 and 22 May 2011. Saturday registration from 9.30am with games commencing at

10am, on the Saturday and 9:30 on the Sunday. Up to two ½ point byes may be taken. Byes will not be granted for the final round. 6 or 7 rounds will be played (an additional game **may** be played if others have been of short duration). It is anticipated that the finishing time on both Saturday and Sunday will be around 5pm. Presentation will take

place at approximately 5pm on Sunday.

Awards: Trophies for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places, 1st under 14, 12, 10 and 8 players, Rising Star and

Most Improved. All participants receive a ribbon – even those over 18.

Where: The school hall, Campbell High School, Treloar Crescent, Campbell ACT.

**Who:** Open to all women and girls – age is no barrier!

Cost: \$30 per player (\$40 if not a current ACTCA or ACTJCL member). Third and subsequent

entries from one family are free.

**Time Limits:** 1 hour per player plus 10 seconds per move from the start. The arbiter has authority to

impose a forfeit time of 30 minutes after the commencement of each round of games. It is a

good idea to be on time!
