



The ACT Junior Chess League presents the **2011 UNDER 14 CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP**



The **ACT Under 14 Championship** is a two-day rated tournament, played with long time controls (60 minutes per player plus 10 seconds per move) and players are expected to record their moves using score sheets. This event is suitable for players with past tournament experience. Please contact us to discuss the format if you are at all unsure. Awards are presented to the players finishing in first, second and third places, first place in rating group A, first in rating group B, biggest upset and first unrated player. Every player receives a participation ribbon.

- When:** **Saturday and Sunday 12 and 13 November 2011. Registration from 9.00 am Saturday.** Play commences approximately 9.30 am. Players may request byes before the commencement of play. Byes will not be granted in the final round. **Sunday games start at 9.00 am.** Presentation of awards approximately 4:45 pm Sunday. Because of the time controls used, exact start times for each round, and our finish time each day, are not fixed. Play will finish between 4:00 pm and 4:30 pm each day. 3 rounds are scheduled each day but, in the event of a very quick round, the organisers reserve the right to add a seventh round to the event.
- Where:** ACT Junior Chess Centre, Campbell High School, Treloar Crescent.
- Who:** Boys and girls born on or after 1 January 1997.
- Cost:** \$30-00 per player (\$35-00 if not a current ACTJCL member). Third and subsequent children from one family are free.
- Entries:** To the Tournament Manager, Frank Derwent, at forderwent@home.netspeed.com.au or phone 6257 8617 a/h by Friday 11 November 2011, including the player's full name, date of birth and a telephone number where a parent can be contacted during the tournament.
- Lunch:** Pizza and soft drink is available for \$7 per player per day and a limited range of snack foods will also be available for purchase.
- Notes:** Players are encouraged to listen to announcements about round times and be on time for their games, as a forfeit time of 30 minutes from the commencement of each round will apply. Parents, please provide details to the organiser of any medical or custodial issues for your child. This should include any known allergies, chronic medical conditions and behavioural issues that may have an impact on your child's participation in, and enjoyment of, our activities. Please make us aware of any medication that your child carries – we will require them to self-administer any medication. Children are not supervised when playing outside the hall at Campbell High. If in doubt please stay and enjoy the weekend with your child.
