At the Olympiad Boot Camp Coaching and Lightning day, players will have a morning of top quality coaching from some of Canberra's best coaches. Coaching will take place in ability based groups over 3 x 1 hour sessions. Afternoon is taken up by fun Lightning and you can top off your "Camp" with the Olympiad Allegro on Tuesday 12th July and Olympiad L T Tournament on Wed 13th & Thurs 14th July (see flyers overleaf).

- When:** Monday 11th July, 9am until 5pm daily.
- Where:** ACT Junior Chess Centre, Campbell High School hall, Treloar Crescent, Campbell
- Who:** Children born on or after 1 January 1996
- Cost:** \$50/day 9am-5pm per child (Coaching plus Lightning)
- Time Limits:** Lightning event is played with a 5min (blitz) time control. New players will have the use of clocks, and the rules for both styles of event, explained on the day.
- Awards:** Each coach will present a prize for outstanding effort on the day. Awards in the Lightning event will include 1st & 2nd overall, with additional prizes awarded based on the number of entries received.
