If you enjoy playing chess, ACTJCL is inviting you to support Canberra's (and Australia's) representative player by participating in the fundraising "Olympiad Boot Camp Long Time Tournament." Canberra Chess Olympian WIM Emma Guo will be heading to Baku, Azerbaijan from the 1st to 14th September 2016.

So if you played in the recent Autumn Weekenders and/or any of our weekend events – *or even if you didn't – this fun event is for you!* Playing conditions are the same as the Autumn Weekenders (that is, games are played with clocks with each player having 60 mins plus 10s). This tournament caters to all standards of play. **All children who can confidently make all the basic moves of chess are encouraged to participate and every participant receives a ribbon!**

- When:** Wed 13th and Thurs 14th July 2016, 9am until 5pm. Presentations at 4.45pm.
- Where:** ACT Junior Chess Centre, Campbell High School hall, Treloar Crescent, Campbell
- Who:** Children born on or after 1 January 1996
- Cost:** \$60 per child for two days – *a great value day of holiday fun!*
- Time Limits:** Games will be played using chess clocks with 60 minutes plus 10s per move. At least 7 rounds will be played and all players participate for the full 7 rounds (except when byes occur). No players are "eliminated" during the day!
- Awards:** Prizes awarded based on the number of entries received! *And lucky door prizes too!*
- Entries:** to Emma Guo at emma.guo@actjcl.org.au or SMS 0401 321 519 by Monday 11th July 16, including child's name, date of birth, school, current school year and a contact no. where a parent can be contacted on the day. **Late entries will only be accepted if space permits– this will be a very popular tournament!**
- Lunch:** Pizza and a drink is available for \$7 per child and a limited canteen will operate on the day.
