ACTJCL 2017 Spring School Holiday Chess Frenzy - Boot Camp long time tournament is a two-day rated event for players born on or after 1 Jan 1997, played with long time controls (60 + 10s) on Thursday 5th & Friday 6th Oct at Campbell High. *This is an excellent practice and warm up for any players participating in the upcoming school team playoff and the Vikings Weekender*.

Players are expected to record moves but if your child has never recorded moves before, or has never played long time control games of chess in a competitive environment, please let us know and we'll provide some instructions prior to the tournament. Please contact us to discuss the format if you are at all unsure.

When:	Thursday 5th & Friday 6th Oct, 9am until 5pm daily. Booking is for both days and Registration is from 8.45am
Where:	Campbell High School hall, Treloar Crescent Campbell
Who:	Children born on or after 1 January 1997
Cost:	\$60 for both days – great value days of holiday fun!
Time Limits:	Time limits will be 60 + 10 secs a move, so excellent practice and warm up for players participating in the school team playoffs and/or Viking Weekender.
Awards:	Prizes in events will include 1 st & 2 nd overall, with additional prizes awarded based on the number of entries received. Every player receives a ribbon!
