



The ACT Junior Chess League presents the 2017 UNDER 12 CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP



This event is suitable for all eligible players who can confidently move the chess pieces around the board. Chess Clocks will be used. Participants in the event will range from potential grandmasters to (almost) complete novices. All players compete for all rounds (unless byes occur). Nobody is "eliminated" during the day.

A minimum of seven rounds will be played with each player having 15 minutes to complete their moves (maximum game time 30 minutes). At the completion of the final round, trophies will be presented to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th placegetters. Additional prizes include a "Rising Star" award (for a most improved player) and "Young Champion" (for a player in Year 2 or below). All children will receive a participation ribbon.

- When:** Sunday, 22nd October 2017, 10am until 3pm (registration from 9.45am)
- Where:** ACT Junior Chess Centre, Campbell High School, Treloar Crescent. We recommend players dress warmly.
- Who:** Boys and girls born on or after 1 January 2005.
- Cost:** \$20-00 per child (\$25-00 if not a current ACTJCL member). Third and subsequent children from one family are free.
- Entries:** To the Tournament Director and Arbiter, Emma Guo, at emma.guo@actjcl.org.au or SMS 0423 284 501 (a/h) by Friday 20th October, including child's name, date of birth, school attended, current school year and a telephone number where a parent can be contacted on the day.
- Lunch:** Pizza and a drink is available for \$7 per child and a limited range of snack foods will be available for purchase on the day.
- Notes:** Parents, please provide details to the organiser of any medical or custodial issues for your child. This should include any known allergies, chronic medical conditions and behavioural issues that may have an impact on your child's participation in, and enjoyment of, our activities. Please make us aware of any medication that your child carries – we will require them to self-administer any medication. Children are expected to behave as they would at school. Please note that children are to remain in the playing hall and are not allowed to play outside at Campbell High, unless there is adult supervision outside. If in doubt, please stay and enjoy the day with your child
