



# The ACT Junior Chess League presents the 2018 ACT UNDER 14/16 CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP



The **ACT Under 14/16 Championship** is one of our major junior chess tournaments for the year. It is a two-day rated tournament, played with long time controls 60mins + 10secs and players are expected to record moves. This event is suitable for players with past tournament experience and players who want to start playing long time control games. If your child has never recorded moves before, or has never played long time control games of chess in a competitive environment, please contact us to discuss the format if you are at all unsure.

***This is a fantastic event and warm up for any player participating in the upcoming Vikings Weekender and Australian School Team Chess!***

Awards are presented depending on numbers. This event caters to various levels of skill and experience. Every player receives a ribbon!

**When:** **Sat 10<sup>th</sup> and Sun 11th November 2018.** Saturday registration from 9.30 am. Play by 9.45am. Sunday games will start at 10am. Players may request any number of byes before the commencement of play. Presentation at approx. 4:45pm, Sunday.

Because of the time controls used, exact start times for each round, and our finish time each day, are not fixed. Most players will be finished between 4pm and 5pm each day, but it could be a bit later, particularly for juniors who take their time!

3 rounds are scheduled each day but, in the event of a very quick first or second round, organisers reserve the right to add a seventh round to the event.

**Where:** ACT Junior Chess Centre, Campbell High School, Treloar Crescent.

**Who:** Boys and girls born on or after 1 January 2002.

**Cost:** \$40-00 per child (\$50-00 if not a current ACTJCL member). Third and subsequent children from one family are free.

**Lunch:** Pizza and a drink (including water & Juice) is available for \$7 per child and a limited range of snack foods will be available for purchase on the day.


