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Hail to the Champions!

Indeed, a hearty congratulations to all the winners – we got outright winners in all four events, and also a piece of history! This meant that we managed to survive the usual harrowing final day, although we could not avoid a few playoffs: for the Under 16 Girls, Under 10 Open and Under 8 Open titles. If you want to find out the players involved and the winners of these playoffs, then you need to read on, dear readers... As for the piece of history, the same applies. And if the manner in which you read on is somewhat picktooth, you can be assured that we will not hold that against you; the event is over, and we can all relax...

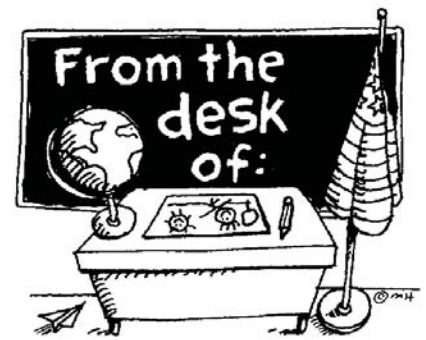
It has been a fantastic event, not least for our already crowned Under 18 Girls Champion Emma Guo; she won again today from pawns ahead against Nina Horton, making her final winning score 10/11. Molly McGarity won Deborah Ng's queen, and that was that; but only equal second for her on 8.5/11 and a playoff for the Under 16 Girls title with Sally Yu, who took care of Savannah McGuirk by winning lots of material to her usual tactics... Sally won the rapid (15 minute) playoff 2-0, leaving her the Under 16 Girls Champion and Molly the Under 14 Girls Champion. The Under 12 Girls saw no playoff, as Megan Setiabudi wrapped up the title on 9.5/11 by defeating Elizabeth Behne-Smith after the latter popped a piece early. Abbie Kanagarajah was second on 8.5/11 after her win over Lucinda Flood (winning a rook to more tactics); while Clarise Koh won a piece early from Mirakla Mithran then offered a draw (accepted) to guarantee herself third place and the Under 10 Girls title on 7.5/11. (In case you are wondering, Amy Nicholson was the winner of the Under 8 Girls title).

The Under 12 Open was perhaps a bit more exciting, as Yi Yuan kept the pressure on Gene Nakauchi by winning a nice attacking game against James Li; he sacrificed the exchange, but his two beautiful bishops meant that his attack was decisive. Gene kept calm, however, his powerful White d7 pawn eventually forcing the win of a piece against Alex Stahnke; he returned the piece to force a won knight and pawn ending two pawns ahead, which he duly converted to the full point. So Gene came first and won the Under 12 Open title on 9.5/11, with Yi having to be content with second by half a point for the second year in a row... The real excitement though was in the Under 10s, where Joshua Lau's marathon endgame victory over Oscar Wang (whose passed rook pawn was stronger?) forced Oscar into a playoff for the Under 10 Open title with Ryan Sam on 7.5/11. A large number of people had to joss against the window to watch the two exciting rapid playoff games, which finished at 1-1; but Oscar then won both blitz (5 minute) games to wrap up the Under 10 Open title. Meanwhile Anton Smirnov and Clement Poh (both 5/11) played off for the Under 8 Open title; this was won 2-0 by Anton, who is in fact still under 6 years old!

Michael Wei offered Andrew Brown an early draw to guarantee himself the Under 18 Open title, but Andrew judged this to be infradig; sadly for Andrew he lost pawns and a longish endgame instead! So Michael Wei was the first Australian Junior Champion to ever hail from the ACT (the piece of history referred to above), finishing on the outstanding score of 10/11. Chris Wallis and Zhigen Lin were equal second on 9/11, Chris finishing with

a nice attack against Miles Haselgrove while Zhigen was lucky to survive an inferior position against William Xu when the latter walked into a mate. This gave Zhigen the Under 16 Open title, while James Morris (7.5/11) took the Under 14 Open title after a lengthy endgame win against Fedja Zulfic. Ben Lazarus rounded off the event with an upset win over Junta Ikeda, Junta's king ending up in a mating net in time pressure; these two thus finished equal fourth on 8/11.

Naturally it would be remiss of me to close without thanking everyone

who has made this fantastic tournament possible; too many to list here, but all acknowledged in earlier bulletins! Special mention though to my colleague, the great IA Roland Eime; and to Libby and Mike Smith, without whose Herculean efforts the event would never have happened. I am being veriloquent when I say they have run the best Australian Juniors ever – and not just in terms of numbers! A hard act to follow for Sydney 2008... And on that note, this is bulletin blurb editor Charles Zwoestine signing off for now; hope to see you all again at the next big event!

(1) Guo, Emma - McGuirk, Savannah C50 Girls U18 (10), 25.01.2007

1.e4 e5 2.Nf3 Nc6 3.d4 exd4 4.Bc4 h6 One of the best features of White's move order is that so many players seem to have a compulsion to play this move rather than transpose to a relatively harmless Two Knights with 4...Nf6 or Giuoco with 4...Bc5. What happened to all those megabytes of opening theory that juniors supposedly have loaded into their brains?

5.0-0 Bc5 6.c3 At first glance a type of Goring Gambit which Black does best to take, otherwise White just gets two large centre pawns for nothing. However White has an option not normally available in the Goring.

6...dxc3 7.Bxf7+ Kxf7 8.Qd5+ Ke8 9.Qh5+ Kf8 White's last move looks like a clever way of picking up the Bishop with check, and so also saving a pawn, because 9...g6 10.Qxg6+ Kf8 11.Qf5+ still retrieves the Bishop, though possibly leaving Black's King on e8 is as good.

10.Qxc5+ d6 In fact Black could in any case win a pawn with 10...Qe7 11.Qxc3 Qxe4 though White has considerable compensation in free development and the exposed Black King.

11.Qxc3 Nf6 12.Nh4 Although the threat to g6 creates some disturbance to Black, this decentralises the Knight. Simple development with 12.Nbd2 or 12.Re1 looks better.

12...Qe8 13.Nd2 Kg8 It's not clear that it's really wrong to take the pawn. After 13...Nxe4 White has nothing immediate. 14.Qc2 Nxd2 15.Bxd2 Kg8 is awkward. But as Steinitz said, you have to be prepared to suffer for an extra pawn, and Black is suffering anyway. Alternatively Black could look for some counter-play with 13...Qh5.

14.b3 Nxe4 Too late now. **15.Qc4+ Kh7 16.Nxe4 Qe5 17.Qc2 Nd4** Allowing a picturesque finish.

18.Nf6# 1-0

(2) Ryan, Sam - Yuan, Yi C55 Juniors U12 (10), 25.01.2007

1.e4 e5 2.Nf3 Nc6 3.Bc4 Nf6 4.Nc3 Nxe4 5.Nxe4 d5 6.Bd3 dxe4 7.Bxe4 Bd6 In the Round 2 annotated game we saw this

variation with colours reversed, White having the extra move a3. Here we see it being played more accurately.

8.Bxc6+ A long time ago analysts identified that White should play 8.d4 as Black benefits from keeping his e-pawn, as we see in this game.

8...bxc6 9.d3 0-0 10.Be3 White may have felt uncomfortable about 10.0-0 Bg4 and Qf6 but he can't really leave the King in the centre.

10...f5 11.Qe2 Now that Bg4 is unavailable may be a good time for 11.0-0 f4 Black gets nowhere with 12.Bd2 Bg4 13.Re1

11...Ba6 12.Qd1 Qe7 13.Bd2 White is dithering - over the last four moves the only change has been the Bishop moving from c1 to d2.

13...e4 14.Bg5 Qe8 15.Nd4 15.dxe4 Qxe4+ 16.Kd2 (16.Be3 f4 wins a piece.) 16...Bf4+ 17.Bxf4 Qxf4+ 18.Kc3 (18.Ke1 Rfe8+) 18...Qc4+ 19.Kd2 Rad8+ wins, and any Knight move is met by a decisive discovered check.

15...exd3+ 16.Kd2 Qe4 17.cxd3 After 17.Nf3 the quickest win is the surprising 17...Rab8 (though no doubt 17...Bf4+ 18.Bxf4 Qxf4+ 19.Kc3 Qc4+ 20.Kd2 dxc2 21.Qxc2 Rad8+ 22.Kc1 Qf4+ 23.Nd2 Rd5 is adequate) when any White defences either worsen the position or don't help, e.g. 18.Rb1 (or 18.Ne1 Bf4+ 19.Bxf4 Qxf4+ 20.Kc3 Qb4#) 18...Bf4+ 19.Bxf4 Qxf4+ 20.Ke1 (20.Kc3 Qb4#) 20...Rfe8+ 21.Kf1 dxc2+.

17.Nb3 Bf4+ 18.Bxf4 Qxf4+ 19.Kc3 Qc4+ 20.Kd2 dxc2 21.Qxc2 Rad8+ 22.Kc1 Qf4+ 23.Nd2 Rd5 24.Rd1 Be2 wins.

Or 17.c3 Bf4+ 18.Bxf4 Qxf4+ 19.Ke1 Rae8+ 20.Kf1 d2+ 21.Kg1 Re1+.

17...Qxd4 18.Qb3+ Kh8 19.Be3 Qb4+ 20.Qxb4 Bxb4+ 21.Ke2 Rad8 22.Rhd1 Rfe8 23.Kf3 Bxd3 24.Kg3 Bd6+ 25.Kh3 Be2 26.Re1 Rxe3+ 27.f3 Even without the Queens on White is getting mated: 27.fxe3 Bg4+ 28.Kh4 h6

27...Rde8 28.Rec1 R8e6 29.g4 Bxf3 30.g5 R6e4 31.Rg1 Re2 32.Rg3 Bg4+ 33.Kh4 Rxh2+ 34.Rh3 Rxh3# 0-1

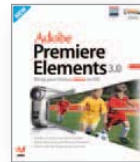
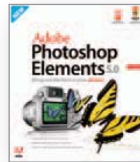
