In another first, 2007 is the first year that the Australian Chess Federation will officially recognise both an Under 8 Open Champion and an Under 8 Girls' Champion.

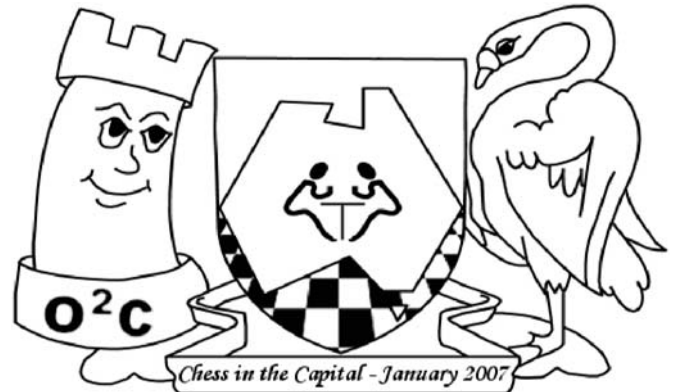
We have assembled a great group of volunteers to run this mammoth event for you. And I'll take this opportunity to thank everyone in advance – it can't happen without you!

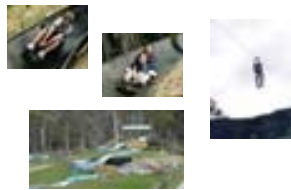

Corin Forest is a year round recreation facility with an emphasis on mountain sports and activities located just 45 minutes drive from Parliament House, Canberra, on an all sealed road.

Corin Forest is open weekends, public holidays and A.C.T. school holidays at 10am until 5pm

Ride the stunning 1.2km Corin Forest Bobsled Alpine Slide! Watch the Native Forest blur past at speeds up to 60km/h, or enjoy it at your own pace! It's your choice.

Corin Forest has dual 350 metre long recreational flying foxes. These "zip wires" allow you to descend some 36 vertical metres in as little as 18 seconds. They are the longest recreational flying foxes in Australia!

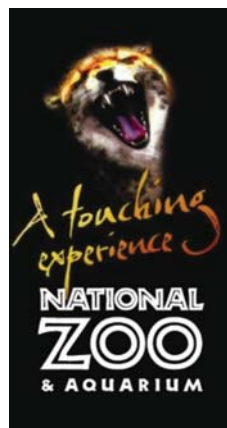

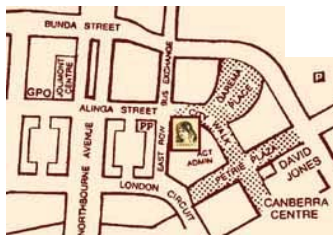
