



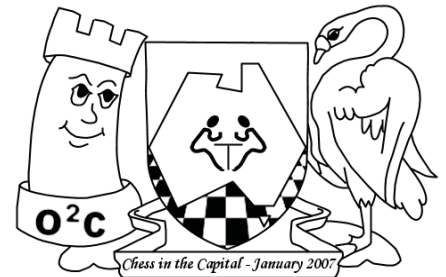

Old Parliament House Comes Alive!

Built in the 1920s, this beautiful National Heritage Listed place and award-winning tourist attraction brings to life the stories of our Australian democracy with a range of exhibitions, tours, talks and events.

You might catch a talk on a former Prime Minister, hear a concert in King's Hall, take a guided tour through the House, relive a momentous event or simply bask in the historic atmosphere as you revisit our past with our fascinating and changing program of exhibitions.

Exhibitions now on at Old Parliament House include Leaks, scoops and scandals: The Press Gallery 1927-1988, Destination Australia: Ports of Immigration and In the line of Duty: Policing Australia 1788-2006.

There are fun activities for kids too, such as a clue hunt around the House, dress-ups in period costume and other special kids' activities. All events are free after entry.

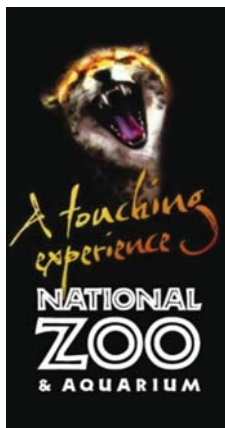
